4th Annual New Mexico State Fair Queens Clinic Coming to EXPO New Mexico

Space is limited; all statewide contestants encouraged to register now

ALBUQUERQUE, NM – The 4th Annual New Mexico State Fair Queens Clinic is coming to EXPO New Mexico on Saturday and Sunday, July 9 and 10, 2011. This annual Queens Clinic is the best, most comprehensive of its kind in the state in preparing young women from all of New Mexico's 33 counties to serve as State Fair Queen.

"More than anything else, being New Mexico State Fair Queen is about being an ambassador for the State Fair and its more than 70 years of culture and tradition," said NMSF Queens Coordinator and former New Mexico State Fair Queen, Temple Palamara. "We hold this clinic every year to give as many young women in the state as possible the opportunities and knowledge required to serve their state, their Fair, and the rich traditions that make the New Mexico State Fair so important."

There is a \$25 Registration Fee, with all proceeds benefiting the 2011 New Mexico State Fair Queen Contest. Clinic programming includes:

- **Saturday** – Horsemanship Clinic including instruction in proper horse care
- **Sunday** – Make-up Clinic, Modeling & Stage Presence instruction, and public speaking instruction led by professional clinicians

Horse stalls and participant accommodations provided at no additional charge. Participants must provide own bedding, feed, tack and other standard equine equipment. Check-in available Friday night or Saturday morning. Saturday lunch will be provided at no additional charge.
